How Has MPAS Helped Your Profession?

- Allowed MPMA to join a coalition of providers to push legislation to reform the burdensome prior authorization process in Michigan. Senate Bill 247 has passed the Michigan Senate and will streamline prior authorization allowing you to spend more time with your patients.
- Allowed MPMA's Government Affairs Committee to participate in private receptions with leaders from the Michigan House of Representatives and Michigan Senate to share the day-to-day issues that we see at our offices.
- Got Senate Bill 901 signed into law to update the Scope of Practice for Podiatrists in Michigan. This was long overdue and now allows DPM's to practice to their full training and education. It's now Public Act 355 in our state and hopefully encourages the youngest and brightest to stay or come to Michigan.
- Protected you and your practice from overreaching insurance reform proposals from Insurance companies.
- Got Podiatrists eligible for Medicaid reimbursements again after being removed during tough budget times in Michigan.
